LOCAL PLANNING POLICY LPP/02 – ADVERTISING SIGNS AVAILABLE FOR PUBLIC COMMENT

Notice is hereby given that the Town of Port Hedland (the Town) has initiated the above mentioned Local Planning Policy.

The Policy has been developed to provide guidance on signage and instances where development approval is not required from the Town.

Objectives of the Policy include:

- Ensure that the display of signage does not adversely impact the level of safety for motorists, cyclists, and pedestrians by obstructing sight lines;
- Ensure that the display of signage does not adversely impact on the amenity of neighbouring land;
- Protect the significance of heritage places and buildings;
- Ensure that signage is established and maintained to a high standard.

The Policy has been deposited at the Town's Administration Office located at the Civic Centre on McGregor Street, Port Hedland and will be open for review during office hours up to and including close of business on the **18 September 2019**.
