ADOPTION OF TOWN OF PORT HEDLAND WASTE AMENDMENT LOCAL LAW 2022

The Town of Port Hedland has resolved to adopt the Town of Port Hedland Waste Amendment Local Law 2022.

The purpose of this local law is to provide a statutory framework to regulate the collection, disposal and storage of waste and recyclable materials within the Town of Port Hedland (Town).

The effect is to stipulate the responsibilities of the Town and its residents in relation to waste management, including the collection, disposal and storage of waste and recycling materials for the benefit of the community and protection of the environment, and to provide capacity to enforce contraventions to the laws.
