The Town continues to work with contractors and the YMCA to complete final works required for the opening of Marquee Park and the South Hedland Aquatic Centre.

The projects are progressing steadily, with a view to ensuring that when the facilities open to the community they are safe and provide maximum enjoyment and benefit to our residents and visitors.

The Town will confirm opening dates for Marquee Park and South Hedland Aquatic Centre once we are confident that both facilities meet necessary standards and approvals and are of the highest quality.

## Marquee Park, South Hedland

- Residents are reminded to refrain from entering Marquee Park as commissioning and repair works are still being undertaken.
- The water treatment plant will be operating in 'test mode' until the end of the week to prepare for statutory water sampling.
- Statutory water sampling is expected to commence next week, and continue over the following weeks.

## South Hedland Aquatic Centre Redevelopment

- The Town had identified an issue with the water treatment plant, requiring the replacement of the chlorine booster pump.
- The chlorine booster pump replacement will take place on Friday 22 February.

- Community members may observe YMCA staff in the pools undertaking cleaning and vacuuming as part of regular pool maintenance.
