Marquee Park, South Hedland

- Residents are reminded to refrain from entering Marquee Park as commissioning is still being undertaken, and with repair works to the water-play area due to commence, any trespassing could delay the process or pose potential health and safety risks.
- Materials required for splash pad repair works are in transit and work is expected to commence and be completed next week.
- Statutory water samples will be taken in the next fortnight, following completion of splash pad works including curing of the surface.
- Concrete works including installation of path signage and better path connectivity has commenced and is expected to be complete next weekend.
- Vandals have caused minor damage to the kiosk overnight, which will be repaired by the Town immediately.
