Individuals, businesses and community groups are required to submit a booking form and any relevant documents when using the Town of Port Hedland's facilities, reserves, ovals and parks. Meeting any of the following criteria:

1. Sporting fixtures and training on a seasonal basis
2. Events with over 50 attendees (Any event held on council property)
3. If events are open or advertised to the public
4. If there will be any entertainment or structures erected (e.g. Bouncy Castles etc.)
5. If vehicle access is required
6. If food or goods will be sold
7. If alcohol will be consumed or sold
8. Personal training sessions or fitness classes will be conducted
9. When revenue is being obtained by the hirer as a direct result of operating on council property
10. Require access to facilities e.g. change rooms, kiosks or overhead lighting.
