Vehicle Auction, Saturday 20 April 2013



The Town of Port Hedland will be holding a vehicle auction on Saturday 20 April, with 70 vehicles up for auction including ex-Town of Port Hedland fleet vehicles, three small trucks, seven ride-on mowers, one steel road roller, and various small plant items from Parks and Gardens and Engineering services.

In accordance with Section 3.58(2)(a) of the Local

Government Act 1995, disposal of property will be to the highest bidder at public auction. The vehicles are offered 'as is where is' and may be inspected at the Town of Port Hedland Depot, Cajarina Road, Wedgefield on Saturday 20 April 2013, strictly between the hours of 8am and 10am, with registration of all persons bidding also taking place at this time. Auction will start 10.30am sharp and will run until all items have been auctioned. A list of Vehicle Lot Numbers will be available from 8am at the auction.

It is a condition that all persons entering the Town of Port Hedland Works Depot, Cajarina Street, Wedgefield, are to wear enclosed shoes.

Payment is to be made in cash (correct amount) or via EFTPOS on the day. The successful highest bidders for any vehicle will have 16 working days in which to collect the vehicle from the Depot, being Thursday 9 May 2013. All vehicles not collected after this date will be forfeited, and the buyer will forfeit any payment made.
