- ✓ be aged between 15 and 24 years at the age of application
- live within the Town of Port Hedland
- be involved in the local community, for example involved in sporting clubs, community groups or volunteering
- have an interest in wellbeing, community services, youth events and activities, leadership and helping other young people in the community
- have the ability to work in a team, respect others and participate in group discussions as well as working independently

- ✓ have an ability to think about the big picture
- bring motivation, willingness, and commitment to participate on an ongoing basis
- have good communication skills should language barriers occur; the Town of Port Hedland is able to assist
- be willing to be actively involved in conversations and contribute to discussions in a variety of environments and platforms
- prepared to undertake some training
