And you are proposing the same thing, but much worse at Pretty Pool?

I am concerned about the level of traffic and also, how the power grid and sewerage systems will be affected. After the meeting, I do not believe this has even been a consideration.

I attended the information session and I felt that none of these concerns were addressed. I asked the question in regards to all of the facilities being provided, how would it benefit the community as far as injecting cash through local business? The CEO's response was that it won't be affected and that locals use online shopping anyway. Online shopping is absolutely something that people use however, the reason is such that the town doesn't offer everything all the time. This is a ridiculous argument. 348 people flying in and out for shift, being given a restaurant, somewhere to drink, shop and go to the Dr? Why would they leave? Why not put a shop in under the FMG units or BHP units as promised? The only business in there is Atlas which offers nothing to the residents as far as these promises go (I do realise they contribute to the community, I'm talking as far as facilities in Pretty Pool go).

The people that would be utilizing this 'caravan park', won't contribute to the community, so why put it in a spot that the people who do care will be adversely affected? Trying to dupe us with the 'tourist' angle is quite frankly, insulting! Why would backpackers or families want to sit and share a family meal in a mess with 348 blokes? 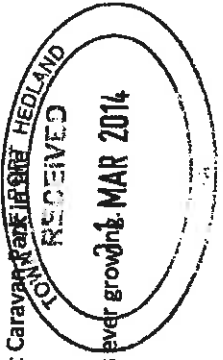

As a long term resident & business owner who has invested millions of dollars into Port Hedland over the past 10 years I have seen many improvements to the town but the amount of multi camp dwellings being approved is concerning to me. This town's workforce is becoming predominately fly in / fly out and contributing nothing to the Community lifestyle as a whole and very little to the economics of daily living for small business operators.

There are a few areas of concerns for me directly on the 'Proposed Pretty Pool Caravan Park Mixed Use development that the ToP is seeking to approve, all of which has brought me to the decision of vehemently opposing the proposal and in such returning your form.

Some of my concerns are dot pointed below;

1. Currently the proposal is for both a Caravan Park & Camp Style accommodation, making even more single fly in/fly out dwellings available. This consists of 36 Caravan Bays, 18 Tent sites and 6 Backpacker rooms & 348 rooms. Do you take your rate payers for absolute idiots that you would even put Caravan Park in Hedland proposal. This is another Camp you are seeking approval for and want built.
2. The proposal appears to currently be for single storey units but so was the proposal for Club Hamilton which has become multi-storey and is ever growing.
 - a. Current camps are not fully occupied.
 - b. Wedgefield Camp closed.
3. The Cook Point Caravan Park has been turned into a fly in/fly out village with all the chalets that have been installed and detrimentally removed Caravan Park Bays.
4. The traffic situation on the Cook Point Road is difficult now, what is the impact to be with all these extra vehicles going to and from a Multi dwelling camp.
5. Pretty Pool is the only area in the whole of the Town of Port Hedland that is purely residential with no current industrial dwellings and attracts owners to want to buy and live in this area.

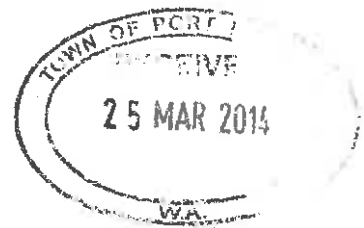
