Register your cat or dog for half price for remainder of 2014

Residents who own a cat or dog are encouraged to take advantage of the 50 per cent reduction in cat and dog registration fees, which expire on 31 October 2014.

In accordance with the Dog Act 1976 and Cat Act 2011, all residents are required to register their dogs or cats with the nearest local government authority.

Registering your pet will assist our Rangers in returning your missing cat and/or dog to you as soon as possible.

Registration fees from now until the 31 October 2014 are:
