Free annual pre-cyclone clean up

The free annual pre-cyclone clean up has started with crews collecting green waste only from South Hedland, Wedgefield and Port Hedland, including the rural estate and Turner River.

Collection started in South Hedland last week and will start in Wedgefield this week. A full schedule of dates can be found in each week's edition of the North West Telegraph or on the **Town's website**.

The Town is collecting green waste only - all other waste will need to be disposed of by the household at the South Hedland Landfill.

Waste must be no longer than two metres in length and residents are asked to place the waste in a neat pile on their verge. Please place waste within a safe distance from your fence and not in the way of any services (power, water, telecommunications etc).

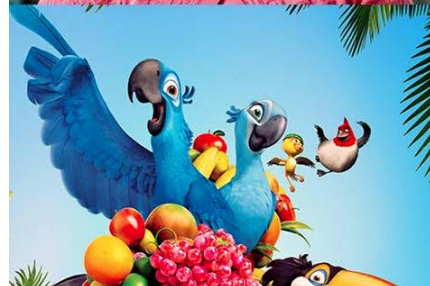
- **The Night Zoo** - Monday 29 September, 4pm
